- 1. Play Provision.** At the meeting of the Council on 6th March Mrs. Breckon of the Forum asked during the public session if the Council would be prepared to lead a community partnership on play provision if the Forum undertook the associated work in sourcing funds. It was **agreed** that the Town Council support the Forum and lead the community partnership. Proposed Cllr. Watkins. Seconded Cllr. Sweet. All in favour.
- 2. Mark Woolgrove Partnership** sent a copy of a letter written by John Bragg to the Cornish Guardian criticising the way the Council arrives at planning decisions. The Town Clerk read to the meeting her reply to Mr. Bragg, pointing out that his observation was incorrect. Councillor Jewels asked for it to be minuted that the Council fully agrees with the reply sent by the Town Clerk.
