38/07 MATTERS ARISING

34/07 (20/07) Dog Control Order. Still trying to get this set up.

34/07 (21/07) Benches KGV. The cost, including installation, would be £60 per bench. **It was proposed** by Cllr. Parsons and seconded by Cllr. May that two benches are installed. All in favour.

34/07 (24/07) Finger Posts. As Cllr. Jewels was not present it is not know what the current situation is.

34/07 (30/07) Weed Spraying. The contract needs to be advertised for tender and the Chairman will liaise with the Town Clerk on the best time to do this.

36/07 KGV/Walkway. An estimate has been obtained in the sum of £680. Further estimates will be obtained before a decision is made.

OTHER MATTERS

39/07 Dog Bins. We have been approached for a dog bin at the bottom of Cott Road near the junction with the A390. The Town Clerk is trying to make contact with someone from Serco who can let us know whether they would empty another bin under the terms of the current agreement.

40/07 Shirehall

- The gates will be locked once the work has been completed
- Various signs are needed and these will be ordered by The Chairman.
- A No Overnight Camping sign is needed for Quay Car Park and this will be dealt with by The Mayor.

41/07 Football Club. KGV has not been rolled. The team has asked if they can get it done at their own expense and then have the pitch free of charge for a few games to cover the cost. It was agreed that the best method would be for them to get the job done and send us the bill for settlement. Proposed Cllr. Jarrett. Seconded Cllr. May. All in favour.

42/07 Allotments.

- Allotment 7 in Long Field is in need of attention and there has been a complaint from the tenant of the adjacent allotment. The rent is due on this plot and a letter will be sent to the tenant detailing the complaint and giving 28 days to respond.
- Cllr. Sweet will draw up a list of all allotment tenants.
