Coulson Park play area. Cllr Robson informed those present that the company he works for recently started trading selling bulk children's safety bark. He is able to get considerable discount approx £60 + VAT per cubic metre (1,000 litres).
[reference; previous purchase of ten similar bags in 2006 cost £899) Cllr Robson will carry out a feasibility study to see if their delivery vehicle can negotiate the 7' 9" height restriction leading to Coulson park. If so will liaise with the chairman to purchase ten 1,000 litre bags for Coulson park play area, which will be subsequently spread out by members of this committee.
