27/08 MATTERS ARISING

22/08 Rotary Carnival Week. Cllr. Watkins reported on the details so far. The list emailed to Cllr. May by Nick Warrick on 12th April was agreed and the Town Clerk will email Mr. Warrick to confirm. A fee for the use of KGV was discussed and **it was agreed** to set this at £150 for the week which can be adjusted if any event is rained off. Proposed Cllr. Watkins. Seconded Cllr. Peareth. All in favour.

23/08 Dog Control Order. It was agreed to put up much bigger signs at eye level in KGV. These will be ordered by Cllr. May from Hot Dog. The Dog Control Order will still be looked into by Councillor Jewels.

28/08 Allotments. Agreements for all tenants to be brought in line with those issued to the new tenants. Allotments to be checked on from time to time by the committee to ensure they are all in order. The problem with allotment 7 was discussed and it was agreed that a letter will be sent stating that as there have been continuing complaints about the condition of the allotment the tenant must give up the allotment forthwith. It was proposed by Cllr. Watkins that the contract is terminated forthwith and the tenant offered a refund for the outstanding part of the year's rent. Seconded Cllr. Parsons. Voted 5 in favour 1 against 1 abstention. Motion carried.

Councillor Sweet left the meeting.

29/08 Football Club. The Football Club want to do maintenance to prepare the ground for next season. Cllr. Watkins will contact them asking for written details of what needs to be done and we will then consider whether we can assist with the cost.

30/08 Trees in The Parade. The trees need to be thinned out. A quote for the work will be obtained. Proposed Cllr. Jewels. Seconded Cllr. Watkins. All in favour. The Town Man will be asked

to clean the top of the wall again and also to put more chippings around the War Memorial.
Cllr. May will obtain a price for the chippings.

31/08 Fields In Trust has contacted us regarding an insurance scheme for NPFA playing fields. Cllr. Jewels will look into it.

32/08 Second Island Park grass. The middle should be cut twice a year to bring it into good order.
Proposed Cllr. Nicholls. Seconded Cllr. Watkins.

33/08 Seat in Coulson Park which was damaged by the falling tree is being replaced by Network Rail. It has to be specially made and we await delivery details.

34/08 Barbeques. New barbeques have been installed, one at the moors and one by the river.

35/08 Tree at bottom of Coulson Park needs to come down. We await a price from Derek Heywood.
