**07/09 MATTERS ARISING**

**01/09 (52/08) Allotments.** One tenant whose signed agreement we were awaiting has lost the document and has requested a copy. This will be sent. The tenant who has asked for a smaller plot is happy to take one of the newly constructed ones and this will enable the person originally offered a smaller plot to be allocated the one now vacated. Plot 14 will be offered to the person at the top of the waiting list and the other newly constructed plot will be offered to the second person on the list. The shed needs to be replaced. All other allotments will be measured with a view to rent increases.

**01/09 (52/08) Fields in Trust.** This is in hand.

**01/09 (52/08) Trees in Coulson Park.** Work will commence in April

**01/09 (56/08) Quay Car Park.** The new sign is in place

**01/09 (61/08) Finger Posts.** Western Power is trying to find out why they were not replaced. They will be contacted again.

**02/09 Dog Bins.** The Town Clerk will place an order for two Glasdon Fido 25 bins.

**03/09 Cemetery.** Regarding animals getting into the cemetery the Police are being contacted as we are concerned about the animals being on the road as well as in the cemetery. A letter will be sent to the owner of the animals stating that if measures are not taken to prevent the animals from straying then we will commence legal proceedings.

**04/09 Pill Walk.** New sign now in place.

**05/09 Shirehall.** Cllr. May and Cllr. Watkins have inspected the site and everything is in order. The Development Trust has been given a key to enable the copse to be cleared. There is concern about the condition of the road and SWW will be contacted

asking them to repair it. They will also be asked to tell their staff to close the gate on their way in and out to prevent members of the public being inadvertently locked in.

**08/09 Moles on KGV.** A mole catcher has contacted us and he will be asked for a quotation and details of his public liability insurance

**09/09 Cemetery Memorial Garden.** Concern about the general condition of the garden. There are some memorials with an edging around, and also some graves have edgings. This is not permitted and The Mayor will speak to the families concerned. The garden will be tidied up. The Mayor, Cllr. Nicholls and Cllr. Watkins will look into it.

**10/09 Second Island.** The paths need attention.

**11/09 Garden of Remembrance.** This is in poor condition and needs some attention. Lostwithiel in Bloom should be looking after it and their Chairman will be contacted.

**12/09 The Parade** needs spraying. Ed Veerman will be contacted.

**13/09 Drill Hall.** A letter will be sent to the M.O.D. regarding the condition and appearance of the hall.
