01/09 MATTERS ARISING

52/08 Allotments. The three available allotments were offered to the first three on the waiting list. One has accepted, one hasn't replied and will be written to giving 10 days to respond, and one would like a larger plot. It has come to the attention of the Chairman that the present occupier of one of the larger plots is finding it difficult to manage and it may be possible for him to transfer to the smaller vacant plot and for the person wanting a larger plot to take his one. This will be looked into by the Chairman and reported back at the next meeting.

To clear the area to possibly create two small allotments will cost £100-£150. **It was resolved** that this work should be carried out. Proposed Cllr. Watkins. Seconded Cllr. Parsons. All in favour.

The shed at the allotments needs to be looked at and this will be done by Cllr. Peareth and Cllr. May.

52/08 Fields in Trust. The Deed of Dedication for Coulson Park still awaits completion and Cllr. Peareth will assist the Town Clerk is gathering the necessary information.

52/08 Trees in Coulson Park. All trees needing attention are of equal status and nothing is dangerous. The contractor will be asked to carry out the work and to commence as soon as possible.

56/08 Quay Car Park. A new sign will be purchased.

61/08 Finger Posts. These were removed by Western Power when they carried out recent works. The one in North Street has been re-instated but the one in Quay Street is still missing. The Mayor will contact Western Power.

02/09 Dog Bin. A request has been received for a new Dog Bin to be put at the junction of Liddicoat Road and Grenville Road. Another bin is also needed at Pill Walk. **It was resolved** that two bins should be purchased and installed. Proposed Cllr. Watkins. Seconded Cllr. Warwick. All in favour.

03/09 Cemetery. Sheep have recently got into the cemetery. There is a small gap in the fence which will be looked at regarding repair. The memorial garden needs some attention and The Mayor is in contact with the Duke of Edinburgh Award group who have agreed to carry out the work.

04/09 Pill Walk. The sign on the gate needs replacing. Cllr. May will deal.

05/09 Shirehall. Several members of the Committee will have a look to see what the current situation is.

06/09 Barbeques. The one at Shirehall is being used as a waste bin. Cllr. May will clear it.
