9/09 Minutes of previous meeting held on 6th April 2009

10/09 Matters arising

11/09 Survey of footpaths.

Unfortunately for various differing reasons certain councillors were prevented from completing this task. It was suggested and agreed that Cllr Pegg will conjure up a pro forma of an inspection sheet for footpaths. This will be promoted to the wider public for anyone to assist with a Town council organised survey of footpaths in 2010. This exercise starting in January, running through to end of March. To that effect a member of the public can request to walk any or some of the paths and fill in the form which will be returned to the town clerk. Any paths not examined will be subsequently walked by a member of this committee, whereupon a fully comprehensive report will be compiled by the beginning of May 2010.

Also Cllr Pegg to confirm that agreement still applies to the new Cornwall council authority which replaced Cornwall County Council. Whilst requesting a definition of what the town council can claim for in reimbursement for work carried out.

12/09 Budget requirements 2010/2011

After a short discussion it was agreed to request a maintenance budget of £1,000 of which approximately 90% can be reclaimed from Cornwall Council.

13/09 Any Other Business.

Beating of Borough Bounds . As we are in an interim year of beating the bounds it was suggested and agreed that an organised walk of the 1685 – 1935 borough bounds be carried out. Cllr Pegg highlighted that due to the location of these ancient boundary stones, prior notification to various landowners will be required and a comprehensive list of walkers will be needed to be sent prior to the event to at least one person whose land we will have to cross. This five mile walk to be carried out on Monday 3rd May 2010. start time 0900.
