Tree by Lostwithiel School: R. Peareth advised that there is a tree by Lostwithiel school that needs to come down a.s.a.p as it has a fungal growth. Derek Hayward is waiting for an opportunity to do it whilst the children are not around. The cost is to be around 8/900 pounds and we agreed to look at trees generally, their safety and reporting at a later meeting.

Drains on KGV: P Watkins brought some diagrams of drainage systems that would improve the situation at the gateway to KGV We agreed to look at this at the next meeting and to have some price indications to discuss.
