

Lostwithiel Town Council Tuesday 5 September 2017

Public Participation

The Council was addressed regarding the following: -

The excellent work undertaken by Biffa employee Joe, shops putting 'stuff' out on the pavements, yellow parking restriction lines not being observed and not being kept visible, the camper van in Quay Street and two vehicles (one clamped) in the Cattle Market car park.

The recent passing of Mr Ralph Keam former Mayor, a request for an update on future provision of the library service in Lostwithiel, the narrow pavement in Summer Street and agenda item 14 Council salutation.

Cornwall Councillor Report

Presentation by Oliver Denne Estates Surveyor South West Water regarding proposed works to Pill Walk/Shire Moor.

Mr Denne began by explaining the background to the approved planning application. Sheet piling is to be sunk into the river bank to protect the edge of the bank, the first stage of the works is scrub clearance and this will probably start next month. During the scrub clearance access to the Moors will be closed for at least two weeks and all vegetation will be cleared in both areas to be sheet piled for a distance of 15 metres from the river bank.

The Moors will be closed again for the duration of the sheet piling works and the public will be kept informed by South West Water's Press Office and an information board on the gate at the end of Coulson Park.
