This year marks the 100th Anniversary of the end of the 1st World War.

To co-ordinate with events nationally commemorating the Armistice, the Services in Lostwithiel will be slightly different from the normal programme.

The Sunday Morning Events

The parade will assemble outside the Drill Hall and march from there at 10.45 am to the War Memorial in time for the act of Remembrance at 11.00 o'clock.

From there it will go up North Street and along Church Lane into St Bartholomew Church for the service at about 11.45 am.

The Sunday Evening Event

This year to mark the 100th Anniversary of the end of WW1 there will be a second service on the Parade by the War Memorial. This is to commemorate those from Lostwithiel who gave their lives in the 1914 - 1918 conflict.

This should start at about 6.45 pm and last about 30 minutes.

It will be a torchlight event.
