Fake NHS COVID-19 vaccine text alert

The 'hook'

- Cyber criminals are using the roll out of the NHS Covid-19 vaccine to target victims with convincing looking text messages
- The texts appear to be from the NHS and state that the recipient is eligible to receive the vaccine
- Recipients are then encouraged to click on a hyperlink to an application form.
- The link takes you to an extremely convincing fake NHS website which asks for personal and financial details
- Remember, the NHS will NEVER ask for your payment details

Other Covid-19 related SMS Scams:

- Fake links claiming a link to the GOV.UK website to claim supposed Covid-19 related payment
- Fines suggesting you have breached lockdown
- Offers of health supplements that will prevent you from becoming infected
- Financial support offers that appear to be from your bank


