



Representation of the People Act 1985 Section 21 (2) a)

3. If more applications are received than vacancies to be filled, the Town Council will decide which of the applications will fill the vacancies.

Qualification Categories

Regarding the arrangements for the filling of any vacancy where co-option applies, in accordance with the Local Government Act 1972 section 79(1) the Town Council may co-opt as a member any person who is legally qualified to hold such office, and who is willing to serve, provided he or she satisfies at least one of the following qualification categories -

- a) is registered as a local government elector for the parish
- b) has during the whole of the preceding twelve months occupied as owner or tenant, any land or premises in the parish;
- c) his/her principal or only place of work during the preceding twelve months has been in the parish;
- d) had during the whole of the preceding twelve months resided in the parish or within 4.8km thereof.

Disqualification Categories

In accordance with the Local Government Act 1972 section 80 a person is disqualified from being a Councillor if -

- a) are employed by Lostwithiel Town Council
- b) are subject to bankruptcy orders
- c) have, within 5 years before taking office or at any time since been convicted in the UK, Channel Islands or Isle of Man of any offence and have received a sentence of imprisonment (suspended or not) for a period of not less than three months without the option of a fine;
- d) are disqualified under Part III of the Representation of the People Act 1983.
