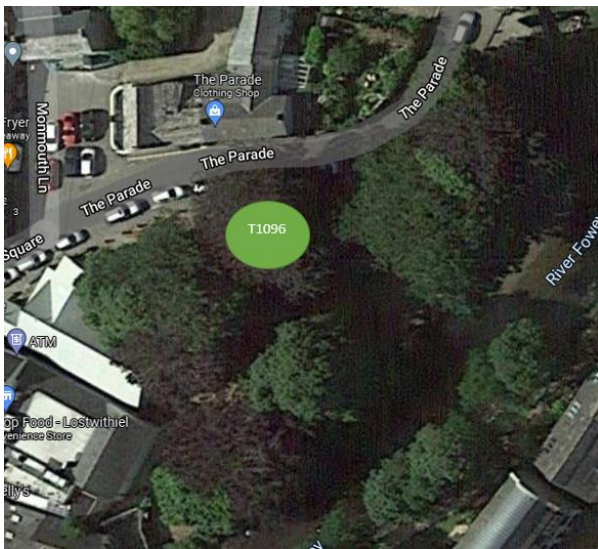




## Lostwithiel Town Council

Following a tree survey undertaken on 13 September 2021 this tree will shortly be felled.

At the Council meeting held on Tuesday 21 September the Council considered the tree safety report undertaken by Land & Heritage following a report of *Meripilus giganteus*.

The recommendation from Land & Heritage was that the tree should be felled as soon as possible.

The Town Council has made a dead and dangerous tree notice form application to Cornwall Council. Under Planning Reference PA21/02506/PREAPP Cornwall Council have confirmed the following - '...the proposed tree works described are exempt from the requirement to obtain consent from the Local Planning Authority under section 198 (6) of the Town & Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended). As such you may proceed with the works described....'

As soon as the Council has a date for removal it will affix a notice to the tree and advertise the date on the Council's website and Facebook page. The Council asks all members of the public not to park along the Parade on the day of the felling.
