# 254/21 Meeting Minutes 11 January 2022

Nurtured Nursery St Winnow C of E School Grenville Road Lostwithiel Non-material amendment in respect of decision PA21/05664 dated 29.07.21 for minor alterations to proposed extensions to include replacement of existing detached office building to current building regulation standards.

It was **resolved** to support this non-material amendment. Votes – 11 in favour.

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#### 256/21 Council Policy Review

#### 257/21 Edgcumbe House

It was **resolved** to spend circa £30,000 to enable the re-opening of Lostwithiel Guildhall building and circa £220,000 on repairs and maintenance to Edgcumbe House with the minimum possible delay to prevent further deterioration to the building and that subsequent decisions will be made on the future of the buildings which will include public consultation will be made as soon as possible.
