Lostwithiel

Demolition of existing outbuildings and the erection of a Café (use Class A3)

It was **resolved** to support the application subject to Cornwall Council adding a planning clause that prohibits the use of the property becoming residential.

Works to trees in a conservation area

(TCA), namely removal of Copper

Beech(T1).

need for Lostwithiel TC to submit any

comments to the Local Planning

Authority.

c) PA21/03338 – Gillyflower Farm Lostwithiel

It was **resolved** to contact Planning Enforcement to report the breaches of planning conditions as below: -

- 1. Contrary to agreement, the golf van is being parked on the field, in full site of the surrounding area. Material screening makes it difficult to know whether refreshments are being served from the van but a generator is clearly audible.
- 2. The entrance was to be surfaced in 'consolidated material', with clear details stipulated around the drainage requirements to control surface runoff. It appears that the vehicular and pedestrian access routes have been surfaced in tarmac.
- 3. It is hard to see how the surfacing of the routes with tarmac ensures that the land could be "returned to its original condition" within three months of the end date of the temporary permission granted (31st October 2022).
- 4. There appears not to be any signage as agreed to warn drivers of pedestrians crossing and walking on the road Votes 13 votes in favour.

 Councillor Guy re-joined the meeting.

098/22 Lostwithiel Town Team Cornwall Council Town Vitality Grant offer – Lostwithiel Heritage Buildings Project

It was **resolved** to note that the Town Team does not wish to make any amendments to the offer letter and to formally agree to act as the accountable body for the funding in accordance with the Terms & Conditions provided and to authorise the signing of the Grant Offer letter.

099/22 Lostwithiel Town Council Annual Review of Castle Hill Cemetery Fees 2022

It was **resolved** to approve of revised fee table as drafted.

Votes – 14 votes in favour.

100/22 Platinum Jubilee Celebrations

It was **resolved** based on the financial information provided to issue a cheque to Really Lovely Projects for £1,000 (as approved under minute reference **021/22**) and to defer consideration of the payment of further funds until the next full Council meeting. Councillor Townsend re-joined the meeting.

101/22 Hire of Town Council Land request

It was **resolved** not to agree to the request from Le Mistral Wine Company to hire part of the Parade as the request is contrary to Council Policy i.e., would mean a vehicle on the Parade. Votes – 12 votes in favour, 1 against and 1 abstention.

102/22 Year End Financial Report

It was **resolved** to approve the Year-end financial report as drafted. Votes – 14 votes in favour.

Councillor Jarrett left the meeting.

103/22 Annual Budget

It was **resolved** to carry forward the earmarked reserves as listed and increase general reserves to £100,000.

Votes – 14 votes in favour.

104/22 Council's Fixed Asset Register Review

It was **resolved** to approve the Fixed Asset Register as drafted.

Votes – 14 votes in favour.

105/22 Internal Audit year end 31 March 2022

It was **resolved** to adopt the Internal Auditor's report.

It was **resolved** to approve the accounting statement in Section 2 of the Annual Return for2021/22; and to authorise the Mayor to sign the Accounting Statement on the 2021/22 Annual Return on behalf of the Town Council. (Statement already signed by RFO prior to the meeting.)

It was **resolved** to approve this policy as drafted.

109/22 Lostwithiel Town Council Standing Orders and Financial Regulations

It was **resolved** to note the alterations made in accordance with minute reference **008/22** and in light of the Council decision made under minute reference **108/22** to increase the limit in paragraph 4.6 from £2,500 to £3,000.

Votes - 14 votes in favour.

110/22 Lostwithiel Neighbourhood Plan

It was **resolved** that in line with best practice and the National Planning Policy Framework paragraph 33 the Town Council should set up a steering group to review the Neighbourhood Plan. The Town Clerk was instructed to invite previous members of the steering group to re-join.

Votes – 14 votes in favour.

111/22 Lostwithiel Conservation Area status

The motion to take forward at the present time the process of creating a Conservation Area Appraisal and Management Plan was defeated. Therefore, Council did not agree to Councillor Barrass making contact with the appropriate officer at Cornwall Council to find out more about the process of creating an appraisal and management plan and inviting the officer to attend a future Council Meeting.

Vote 5 in favour, 7 against.

112/22 8 Pendour Park Lostwithiel

It was **resolved** to instruct the clerk to contact Ocean Housing to advise that Lostwithiel Town Council is appalled at the decision taken not to refurbish and to sell this social housing property.

Votes 14 in favour

113/22 Platinum Jubilee Beating of the Borough Bounds

It was **resolved** to hold the Beating of the Borough Bounds every four years and to mark the next Coronation by placing two new boundary stones. The clerk was instructed to contact John Pegg to ask him to suggest suitable locations for the new stones and to obtain prices from local stonemasons for suitably annotated stones.

Votes – 13 in favour and 1 abstention.

114/22 Friends of Lostwithiel Skatepark

Councillor Anders asked if the 'Friends of Lostwithiel Skatepark' could be an agenda item for the next Council meeting.

It was **resolved** to instruct the clerk to obtain a price for metal benches in order that the Council can consider siting one metal bench at the skatepark sunk in concrete.

Votes – 14 in favour.

115/22 Pendour Park

It was **resolved** to replace the broken picnic bench at the cost of £197.50 plus VAT for a new wooden bench.

Votes – 14 in favour.

116/22 Town benches

It was **resolved** that the Town Council would not be repairing benches sited on the Highway.

Votes – 12 in favour and 2 abstentions.

117/22 New Field allotments

It was **resolved** to instruct the cutting of all the paths in the new allotment field at a charge of £250 for an initial cut and £160 for subsequent cuts. (Maximum cut frequency 3 weeks).

It was further resolved to cut all unused allotments and to purchase and place a breathable membrane on all the unallocated allotments to prevent regrowth.

Votes – 13 in favour and 1 abstention.
