Dear neighbour,

River Fowey – Remedial works, Station footbridge, Resignalling work

We wanted to let you know that we will be working in the Lostwithiel area to carry out a number of projects including remedial works at River Fowey, which involves drainage installation, ballast retention and rebuilding headwall. We will also start our work to install the new footbridge at the station and undertake resignalling work in the area. The site compound for this will be behind the signal box at the station, with deliveries coming along Glenville Road. We will start setting up the compound on 11 September.

We will be working on the below dates and times for each of the above projects, when trains aren't operating, so our teams can work safely, but please be aware these dates may change.
