LP545/11 PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

None.

LP546/11 APOLOGIES

Apologies were received and accepted from Councillor Jewels, Councillor May and Councillor Peareth.

LP547/11 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

Councillor Pegg declared a personal interest in agenda item 6 Allotments/Orchard

LP548/11 TREE INSPECTION

Councillors Mrs Jarrett presented a report to the Committee following the visit by Cornwall Council's Forestry Officer. It was proposed by Councillor Pegg and seconded by Councillor Mrs Jarrett that in light of the report received that the Committee recommends to Council that all vehicle access onto the Parade is prohibited and that the town clerk is instructed to contact Cornwall Council to obtain prices for tree inspections in the various locations on the timescales suggested. This proposal received the support of the Committee.

LP549/11 COULSON PARK

It was decided by the Committee that this agenda item should be referred to Corporate Properties.

LP550/11 ALLOTMENTS/ORCHARD

The Council was updated regarding empty allotments and the town clerk was instructed to check the Council's position regarding the provision of an orchard on three empty allotments and to report back to the next Land & Parks Committee Meeting.

LP551/11 LOSTWITHIEL IN BLOOM

It was proposed by Councillor Pegg and seconded by Councillor Mrs Parsons that Councillor Mrs Jarrett liaises with Lostwithiel in Bloom to draw up an inventory. This proposal received the support of the Committee.

LP552/11 TOWN FLORAL DISPLAYS

It was decided that the Committee would recommend to full Council that an article is put in the Town Council's next quarterly newsletter to encourage residents to do floral displays.

LP553/11 MOLES

It was proposed by Councillor Mrs Jarrett and seconded by Councillor Mrs Parsons that the Committee recommends to full Council that a contractor is arranged to remove moles from the football pitch, the picnic area by the bridge and the cemetery. This proposal received the support of the Committee.

LP554/11 DOG BINS

It was proposed by Councillor Pegg and seconded by Councillor Mrs Jarrett that the Committee recommends to full Council the purchase of five new dog bins. Two bins should be larger capacity than those currently in use and the new bins should all be green. This proposal received the support of the Committee.

LP555/11 SECOND ISLAND BIN

It was proposed by Councillor Pegg and seconded by Councillor Mrs Parsons that the rubbish bin is removed from Second Island and reinstatement considered in six months time. This proposal received the support of the Committee.

LP556/11 SECOND ISLAND SEATS

Councillor Abbiss agreed to check the seats and to make recommendations to the March Land & Parks Committee Meeting.

LP557/11 LAND REGISTRY

Councillor Pegg updated the Committee. It was proposed by Councillor Pegg and seconded by Councillor Mrs Jarrett that the Committee recommends to full Council that all land parcels are submitted for registration as soon as possible. This proposal received the support of the Committee.

LP558/11 GATES

It was proposed by Councillor Pegg and seconded by Councillor Mrs Jarrett that the Committee recommends to full Council expenditure of £180 to improve the gate access to the Cemetery allotments. It was further proposed by Councillor Pegg and seconded by Councillor Mrs Jarrett that the Committee recommends to full Council expenditure of £130 to improve gate access to Bodmin Hill allotments. This proposal received the support of the Committee.
