213/22 Meeting Minutes 01 November 2022.

It was **resolved** that the minutes of the Meeting of the Town Council held on 01 November 2022 are accepted, approved and duly signed by Mayor Ross. Votes – 11 in favour, 2 abstentions.

214/22 Lostwithiel Community Centre – request to endorse C&IOS Shared Prosperity Fund Community Skills application

Councillor Jarrett having previously declared a non-registerable interest left the meeting room.

215/22 Old Duchy Palace Lostwithiel – request to endorse the application to Cornwall’s ‘Good Growth’ Shared Prosperity Fund & National Lottery Heritage Fund

It was **resolved** to give wholehearted support to Cornwall Buildings Preservation Trust’s Tackling Climate Change at the Old Duchy Palace Lostwithiel applications to Cornwall’s ‘Good Growth’ Shared prosperity Fund and the National Lottery Heritage Fund.
