LP487/12 MINUTES

The minutes of the Land & Parks Committee Meeting of 30 October 2012 were approved and duly signed by the Committee Chairman Councillor Pegg. Proposed Mayor Mrs Parsons seconded Councillor Parsons. This proposal received the support of the Committee.

LP488/12 DOG ORDERS

The Committee discussed Mr Browning's presentation. It was proposed by Mayor Mrs Parsons and seconded by Deputy Mayor Mrs Jarrett that the Town Council continues to include dog fouling in the newsletters, improves the signage on the play areas and reviews the situation in six months time. This proposal received the support of the Committee.

LP489/12 PLAYGROUND PROJECT

It was decided by the Committee that it is a good idea to consult with playground users at the skate park event on 9 December 2012. It was proposed by Honoured Burgess Nicholls and seconded by Councillor Parsons that Councillor Mrs Bettin's proposed project phases and delivery timeline are considered by full Council at the December Council meeting. This proposal received the support of the Committee.

LP490/12 COULSON PARK PLAY AREA REPAIRS

It was proposed by Councillor Mrs Bettin and seconded by Mayor Mrs Parsons that the clerk is authorised to instruct the following Coulson Park repairs:-

Senior swings – dig out & re-set legs, construct concrete ramp at gate and the removal of all timber edging and grade ground to a gentle slope. This proposal received the support of the Committee.

LP491/12 COULSON PARK MEMORIAL BENCH

The Committee was advised that the Town Council has been asked if they would consider allowing the siting of a Memorial in Coulson Park. It was proposed by

Honoured Burgess Peareth and seconded by Councillor Mrs Bettin that the applicant is offered two options. Option A to pay for the supply and fitting of a six foot hardwood bench with plaque (if required) or Option B to supply a tree for planting at a location to be decided by the Council with no plaque. This proposal received the support of the Committee.

LP492/12 BUDGET

It was proposed by Councillor Pegg and seconded by Deputy Mayor Mrs Jarrett that the Land & Parks Committee recommends to the Finance, Staffing & General Purposes Committee a Land & Parks Committee Budget of £66654. This proposal received the support of the Committee.
