Construction of one 49m (hub) high 78m (tip) high wind turbine to include ancillary development and provision of new vehicular access. It was proposed by Honoured Burgess Peareth and seconded by Councillor Mrs Ross that this application does not receive the support of Lostwithiel Town Council. The Council wishes to express concern regarding the visible impact that a structure of this size will have on the landscape and the lack of community benefit. This proposal if successful will impact on residents far outside the perimeter of

Lostwithiel & Lanlivery.

#### PL028/13 SOUTH WEST REGIONAL FLOOD AND COASTAL COMMITTEE

Mayor Mrs Parsons reported to the Committee that the meeting was attended by 23 people including The Mayor, Honoured Burgess Peareth and Councillor Pegg. This figure included 9 representatives from the Environment Agency. The Town Council representatives were able to show all attendees the local issues with flooding when walking around the town and explained the issues with the flood wardens, the flood banks and that the town has 275 at risk properties. Mayor Mrs Parsons and Honoured Burgess Peareth explained to Committee that they do not anticipate any feedback from this meeting.

# PL029/13 LOSTWITHIEL TOWN COUNCIL FLOOD PLAN

Councillor Mrs Ross advised the Committee that although the Flood Wardens have been stood down they are still undertaking promotional work in raising community awareness of the role of a flood warden and how the plan will work.

Councillor Mrs Ross further explained to the Committee that following the 2012 flood events the Flood Wardens have requested a locked box to be stored in the Community Centre and that in the event of a Flood there is a nominated individual in the Community Centre to coordinate the Flood Wardens.

The next Flood Wardens meeting will be held on Thursday 23 May at 7.30pm. The clerk requested a list of contact details for all Flood Wardens and it was decided that both the Mayor and Councillor Robson would attend this Flood Wardens meeting.
