### **Meeting Minutes**

### **259/23 Apologies of Absence**

### **260/23 Declarations of Interest**

Mayor Henderson declared a non-registerable interest in agenda item 5 - Stop the Gillyflower Farm Development.

### **261/23 Public Participation**

### **262/23 Meeting Minutes 09 January 24**

### **263/23 Stop the Gillyflower Farm Development**

Mayor Henderson having previously declared a non-registerable interest left the meeting.

It was **resolved** to appoint Councillor Ross as Chair for this agenda item.

Vote – 9 in favour.

It was **resolved** to agree to the request from the Stop the Gillyflower Development group to provide financial assistance for legal scrutiny of the Cornwall Council's Planning Officer's Report relating to PA23/02502, prepared for Cornwall Council's Strategic Planning Committee Meeting, using LGA 1972 s111 to a maximum of £1,674. The funds to be paid directly to Richard Buxton Solicitors with the funds only becoming payable if the Planning Officer's report to the Committee recommends supporting the planning application. Councillor Ross requested a recorded vote.
