Qualification Categories LGA1972 Part V (79)

Regarding the arrangements for the filling of any vacancy where co-option applies, the Town Council may co-opt as a member, any person who is legally qualified to hold such office, and who is willing to serve, is a British or a citizen of the Commonwealth or European Union 18 years old or over and meets at least one of the following qualification categories: -

- (a) is registered as a local government elector for the parish;
- (b) has during the whole of the preceding twelve months occupied as owner or tenant, any land, or premises in the parish;
- (c) his/her principle or only place of work during the preceding twelve months has been in the parish;
- (d) had during the whole of the preceding twelve months resided in the parish or within 4.8 km thereof.

Disqualification Categories LGA 1972 Part V (80)

There are certain disqualifications for election which are listed in the Local Government Act 1972 Part V (80).

This legislation includes the following:-

- a) holding a paid office or employment with the Town Council;
- b) Bankruptcy
- c) Having been sentenced to a term of imprisonment (whether suspended or not) of more than three months, without the option of a fine during the five years preceding thew election and
- d) being disqualified under any enactment relating to corrupt or illegal practices.
