2. Shirehall Moor Variation to Appendix B – The Council's invitation to tender advises that all arisings are to be removed from site. This remains valid for all locations with the exception of Shirehall Moor. At Shirehall Moor, in order to reduce costs, the Council's revised requirement is that the wood is stacked in tidy and purposeful piles deeper into the vegetated areas. The Council has taken advice and the recommendation received is that a structure with 4 small walls is created with bits of trunk and that the gap in the centre is filled with brash and arisings to create a meaningful habitat structure. Random piles of waste left dotted around will not be considered acceptable.
3. Shirehall Moor power lines – some of the Shirehall Moor trees are close to power lines. The Council has contacted National Grid to ask if they can arrange a contractor to address the remedial works required. It is dependent on the response and timeframe received from National Grid as to whether these tree works will be included in the awarded contract.
